Record according to the academic calendar the grades of students for each course offered. Attend other academic, laboratory, research or quasi-administrative assignments, as applicable.

- Doctorate in Clinical Social Work or Psychological Intervention from an accredited Institution.
- Knowledge and skills in utilization of technology for teaching online courses using "Blackboard" platform.
- Fully bilingual in English and Spanish
- Two years' experience in mental health or clinical social work.
- Two years' experience in teaching social work at college level including research and publications.

Minimal competencies: Mastery of the aspects of the discipline or subject to teach. Keep up-to-date on new developments and strategies for the teaching and teaching process. Possess effective oral and written communication skills. Ability to promote discussion of ideas, critical thinking and intellectual development of students. Demonstrate commitment and willingness to offer academic counseling to students. Preferably mastery in the application of technology to the teaching-learning processes, the offering of distance or hybrid courses and the process of appraisal of programs. Knowledge and mastery over the formulation and drafting of proposals for obtaining external funds. Ability to work in teams and establish effective working relationships. Availability to work in different schedules according to the service needs.
